We are looking forward to welcoming our students to Scoil Mhuire. Our main aim is the well-being of our school community. Things will be different. If we all focus on the health of each of us as individuals, and as a community, we'll be fine.

Here are the latest details regarding the return to school:

Déardaoin 3ú Meán Fómhair: 8:55 – 1:10	Daltaí Bl. 1 & 5, 3 & 6
Dé hAoine 4ú Meán Fómhair- Lá iomlán	Gach dalta ar scoil

- Students are permitted on campus from 8:35am, but not before. *(There won't be a formal staggered drop-off unless this is deemed appropriate at a later stage.)*
- Each student must wear a suitable face-mask at all times where a 2m distance cannot be maintained. This means that both teachers and students will wear a mask most of the time. *Teachers will incorporate 'breathers' (time without the mask) for students as often as possible outside the classroom or in the tionól/hallway.*
- Students should proceed directly to their base classroom on arrival in the morning, sanitizing their hands before entering the classroom. Their lockers are in the classrooms.
- Entry doors for class groups should be used as indicated below.
- The following table shows the base classroom for each group;

• B11 – Seomra 9	• B11 – Doras Tionól
• B12 – Seomra 10	• B12 – Seomra 10
• B13 – Seomra 6	• B13 – Doras Tosaigh
• B15 – Tionól & Seomra 1	• B15 – Doras Tionól
• B16 – Seomra 5	• B16 – Doras Tosaigh

- Students will be supervised, as normal until the first class @8:55
- Students will not be permitted to leave the campus to go to the shop and the 'siopa' won't be delivering to the school. Students must bring their own lunch for both breaks. The microwave or fridge will not be available. Students should not share food/drink.
- There will be extra cleaning of classrooms during the school day when rooms are vacated.
- On entering a shared classroom (Eolaíocht, Ríomhairí etc) students will need to wipe their own work area and seat with wipes supplied.
- Break-times will continue as before, but classes will be treated as 'individual bubbles'. If deemed appropriate, break-times will be staggered.
- No more than two students should be in each of the main toilet blocks at a time.
- Students need to be reminded of their own personal responsibility with respect to all of these matters.
- Any behaviour that jeopardises the health of anyone in the school or which inhibits our attempts to ensure compliance with the guidelines will not be tolerated.
